- 20 free rides every month on the Metro, LA DOT, Antelope Valley Transit Authority, Culver City Bus, Foothill Transit, Glendale Beeline, and many other transit operators (or receive a discounted pass dependent on eligibility)
- Eligibility requirements:
 - Live in L.A. County AND
 - Low-income household OR
 - Currently enrolled in CalFresh, CalWORKs, Medi-Cal, a reduced lunch program, Social Security, or Social Security Disability
- English and Spanish applications

For Blue Shield Promise Medi-Cal Members BlueShieldCA.com

- Free transportation to and from doctor's appointments for members
- Free non-emergency medical transportation must be requested through your doctor, who sends the request to Blue Shield Promise
- Must schedule ride one day before transportation is needed
- Schedule a ride or get more information: call (877) 433-2178, available 24/7

For L.A. Care Health Plan Members LACare.org/members/transportation

- Free emergency and non-emergency transportation for members
- May need a prior authorization
- Members can call (888) 839-9909 to hear options for their plan and schedule a ride

- Free transportation available to members
- Only for medically necessary services
- Doctor must sign a Provider Certification Statement prior to receiving transportation
- Request non-emergency medical transportation through third party American Logistics
